Lady Fenwick Chapter Scholarship

The Lady Fenwick Dorothy Capella Scholarship is awarded to a graduating high school student who is a US citizen and a resident of Cheshire or Prospect, and who will pursue an undergraduate degree with a concentrated study of a minimum of 24 credit hours in American History, Civics, Criminal Justice and/or American Government. This scholarship is renewable for the duration of 3 years following the freshman year of study. Renewal is conditional upon maintenance of a GPA of 3.25 and remaining at a nationally or regionally accredited college or university. This award is intended to promote the study of our country's history among our finest students. Scholarship amount: \$1000

Renewable amount: \$500 annually for 3 years following the freshman year of study provided proof of current attendance & transcript with GPA of 3.25 from a nationally or regionally accredited university or college.

Application Requirements: (a) downloaded application from Lady Fenwick DAR Chapter website: LadyFenwickDAR.org (b) high school transcript from your school (or equivalent if home-schooled); (c) 2 academic references & 1 personal character reference; (d) proof of US citizenship (*birth certificate, passport, SSN card*); (f) proof of residency in Cheshire or Prospect (drivers license, letter, etc) and (e) an essay (*1 page, single spaced, typed*) on ***“Why you want to study American History, Civics, Criminal Justice and/or American Government and how will your pursuit of this degree positively impact the modern discourse?”***
